just outside of Kremmling, Colorado. This high mountain valley is famous for its fabulous views, friendly people and world class trout fishing! Our fly fishing season up here typically runs from April through October.

Our anglers have the opportunity to choose between lakes, river or stream fishing when booking their trip with us. The centerpiece of our private water is Troublesome Creek. Anglers who have fly fished this great stretch of the Troublesome consistently rank it as one of the best trout waters they have ever experienced. With nearly four miles of intensely managed private fishing, it's easy to see why the Troublesome Creek is so popular among today's most discriminating fly fishermen. Our success has resulted from simply providing what every angler is looking for, a truly private experience with great guides and a wonderful diversity of both trout and fishing challenges. The diversity is really what sets the stream apart from the rest, as anglers have the opportunity to test their skills in a number of different fishing situations, against a mix of the most formidable trout ever assembled. The Troublesome is home to a great mix of both size and species of trout. A day on the stream provides you the opportunity at rainbows, browns, brookies, cutthroats and cuttbows. Most trout are in the 16-20" range, but it is not uncommon for our anglers to land the fish of a lifetime here, some going over the 10 pound mark!



In addition to the Troublesome Creek, we also have exclusive access to several private trout lakes. These stillwaters hold some truly amazing trout and landing these trophy fish will test the skills of even the most veteran anglers. Numerous hatches throughout the season provide some great dry fly action. Many of our guests reserve several days to make sure they have enough time to experience all of our great private trout water.

Whether you're an experienced fly fisherman or a first timer, we have a friendly, experienced, hard working staff of guides ready to share their knowledge with you. They can set you up with anything you may need for the day, including rods, reels, waders and tackle. Your time on the water will be spent with a focus on enjoyment and relaxation as you explore the many different challenges the water has to offer. Booking Your Trip

We require a 50% deposit to secure your fishing trip with us, and the balance for the trip will be due prior to the start of fishing. Each fisherman will be given a written "client agreement", that outlines the details of their trip with us. We also provide fishermen with a packet of information that helps them plan and prepare for their upcoming trip with us, including travel plans, licensing and a checklist of what to bring.

Because we limit the number of fishermen we take, spots fill up quickly, the sooner you can make your plans with us the better.
